CURRENT HOME STATUS.

Children's Welfare.

Today we are caring for twenty four (24) children fourteen (14) girls and ten (10) boys.

New Admissions.

On 3/3/2016 Mutegeki Francis 2 years and Birungi Lucy 1 year were admitted from Lyamabwa-Kisomoro-Kabarole District.

Their mother and father are alive but unable to care for a big family.

The Children were recued by the probation officer Kabarole District who had visited the place and found the mother with another newly born baby on the breast.

Lucy one year with no food and milk a house almost falling. The children in sorrow state with jiggers all over their body. She made a decision to remove Lucy 1 year and Francis 2 years from the mother leaving he with the newly born baby and the other older children because they could not survive in the condition they were in.

The father was imprisoned of family negligence.

The Children have since greatly improved.

On 6/4/2016

Isingoma Adolf and Kato David aged -1 day old (twins) were admitted after the demise of their mother from Nyahuka Bundibugyo District. Their father got a mental break down after understanding that the wife has passed away.

The babies have a steady progress-Kato was admitted to Kabarole Hospital for 3 days but has since improved.

On 25/3/2016 Karungi Golden Purity 1 day old was abandoned at Golden Vessels church Bukwali Bwera 'B' Kabarole District. The baby is doing well but taking too much tinned milk which is expensive.

Kasiisi Project.

The Kasisi project where we get bananas and milk is doing well but currently the 2 cows that give us milk are in calf.

Kagote Project.

The Kagote Sustainability project is still on the foundation level. The Home failed to get another donor to take up to fulfill its dream of sustaining the home on a monthly basis.

We have planted one hundred more trees.

Tractor.

It was a trial model and it has not really performed due to several break downs and right now it is under repairs.

Poultry Project.

We have successfully done well-by selling the cocks and the hens have started lying eggs.

The nutrition of Children improved since each is getting an egg after 2 days.

Renovation.

House number 6 bathrooms were worked on, painted and now it has anew and good look but my camera is poor and can not get out the picture well.

REPORT ABOUT HILLARY.

Hillary's family was visited on 3rd May 2016.

He was fine trying to get used to the situation at home and creating relationship with the older sister about 9 years old.

He could recognise us very well mentioning our Petty names.

Hillary looked as if he had lost weight when we asked the father he informed us that he is on a small a plot struggling to get food. Decision to buy him food was made immediately. We bought 25 kgs maize flour, 25 kgs Beans,15 kgs groundnuts and 3litre of cooking oil worthy 270,000. He also requested for a mattress and bed sheets which we are going to buy and send you a final report.

The school was visited where he is going to study from there is a distance from his home place but the father was willing to take him to school on a daily basis.

He is going to attend Tweet and Tutus Kindergarten. The term will begin 6th June 2016.
